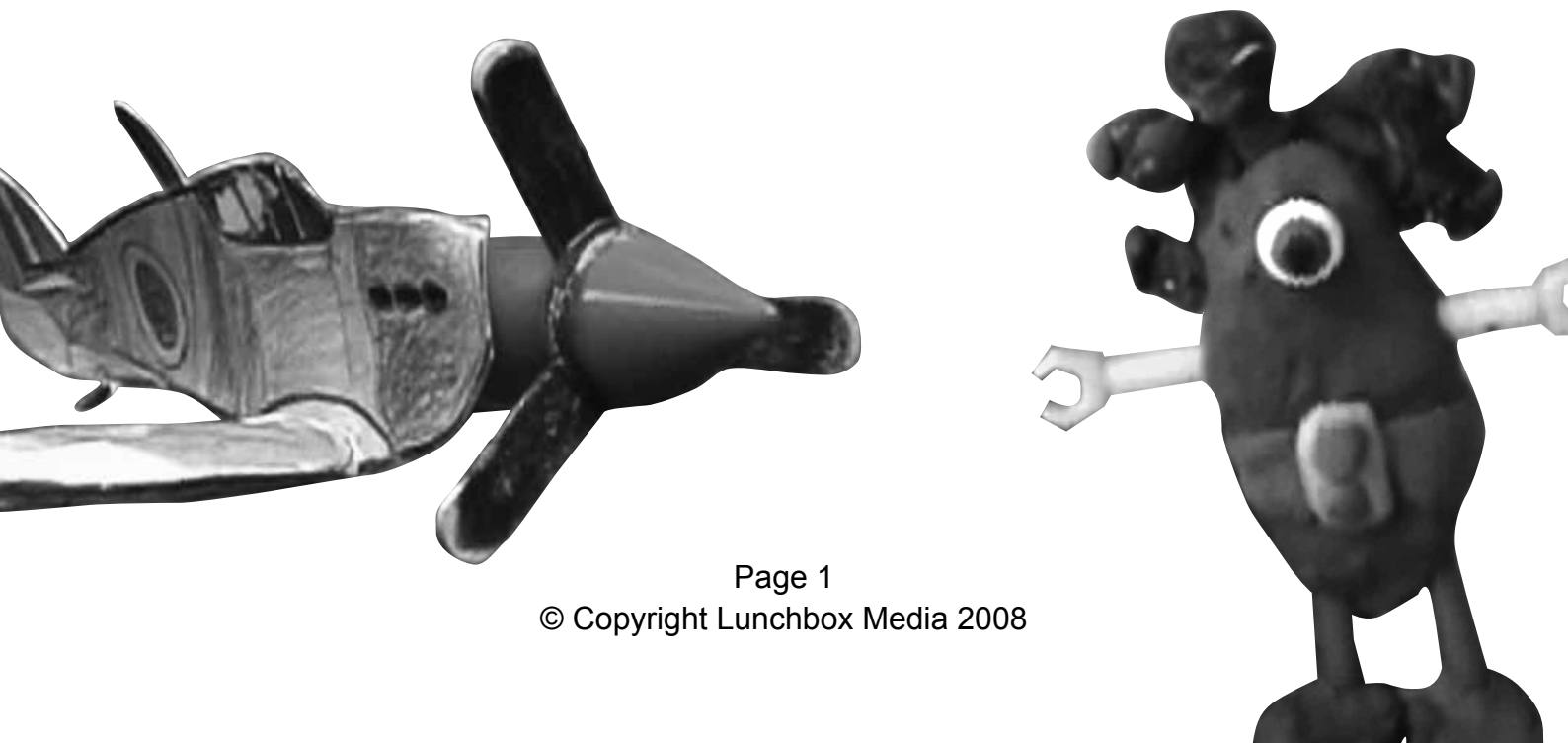
# Our mission is simple - KEEP KIDS ANIMATED!

## Workshops in schools

Lunchbox Films holds workshops to suite all ages and timescales!

Our workshops guide pupils through the process of film making. Our aim is to make the experience as organic and creative as possible. We do this by allowing each child to have input into all aspects of the workshop. As individuals and as a group they will brainstorm the initial concept, create a narrative, story-board scenes, make models, sets and characters, animate, operate cameras, direct scenes, record sound effects and compose an original soundtrack!

At the end of the workshop we hold a premiere for the final film. After the screening each child will receive a certificate commemorating their experience with Lunchbox Films.
